



Post-Pledges FAQs

HOW MUCH WAS PLEDGED FOR OUR CAMPAIGN?

As of April 29, 2024 we had 89 individuals/families pledge \$730,711.68!

DID WE REACH OUR GOAL?

Our stretch goal was \$1.1M but our hope was at least \$700K. We didn't reach the stretch goal but we can do a lot with \$730K+. We are excited for what we will be able to do with these funds!

DO WE CONSIDER THIS CAPITAL CAMPAIGN TO BE A SUCCESS?

We have said all along that this will be a successful campaign if everyone seeks the Lord, listens, and then does what he says. If every family did that, then yes this was a huge success! From a dollars and cents perspective, still reaching at least \$700K for a church that has never done a capital campaign of this size is a big deal and we celebrate this milestone moment in the history of our church.

WHEN SHOULD I START GIVING?

As soon as you are able. If you can stick to your commitment timeline, that helps us out tremendously to know where we are and how the funds are coming in relative to expectation.

HOW MUCH HAS BEEN GIVEN THUS FAR TO THE BUILDING FUND?

As of April 30, 2024 we have received \$376,465.82!

WHEN WILL THE REMODELING START?

Hopefully by late summer/early fall.

WHAT WILL BE THE ORDER OF THE WORK AND THE TIMELINE?

This is still to be determined. We were waiting on the pledged amount and to get an estimate on costs for our three project areas: Children's Ministry, Lobby/Community area, and our Sanctuary. With Adam being one of the elders and going on Sabbatical on May 12, we are going to wait until he returns to make those final decisions. That's why we hope to start in late summer/early fall but that is tentative. We will prioritize areas during this time and we hope to start with our top priority (whatever that is) and then go from there.

As a reminder, we have hired T&W Construction to manage the project and they only work with churches. They know how important Sunday is and will ensure our space is safe for our normal Sunday morning gathering activities.

HOW WILL THE FUNDS BE ALLOCATED?

Some of the funds will cover the campaign consultant we hired, various materials we needed throughout the process, and T&W's costs. The remaining amount will be fully devoted to the remodeling we are planning. As far as how much each area will receive—Children's, Lobby, and Sanctuary—that will depend on the final costs and what we decide to do.

ARE WE WAITING UNTIL WE HAVE MONEY IN HAND TO DO THE WORK OR WILL WE TAKE OUT A LOAN?

We want to get this done as soon as possible and since we are giving two years to allow people to fulfill their pledge, we are planning to borrow the amount we need to cover the work. Our limit will be \$730K minus cash on hand given to the building fund and campaign costs.

WHAT IF I AM UNABLE TO FULFILL MY PLEDGE?

We understand that unexpected circumstances in life happen and there may need to be times to adjust. We will not make anyone fulfill their pledge if something like this happens. If this is the case, please do let us know. We will not put any shame on you but would love to know for our tracking purposes and to pray with and for you.
