

CANDIDATE INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

Focus on how you "feel" about the candidate, and when in doubt, ask the lady(ies) of the house. Many studies reflect the accuracy of a Woman's Intuition, even the CIA and Mossad's best spies are women (Forbes - Why The Best Spies in Mossad And The CIA Are Women – Sep 30th 2012).

However, sometimes it's nice to have some questions to ask to drive the conversation. Below is a list of questions that should help you better identify some of the traits you are looking for in a candidate.

CHARACTER

- If from your perspective we are being over-demanding or unreasonable in our requests, how will you address it?
- If an employer ever put your back against the wall to do something that you thought was wrong, and what did you do in the situation?
- Can you tell me how you deal with stressors in a high-stress situation?
- How do you respond to negative feedback or criticism when you confidently know in your mind that you are correct?
- How do you like to manage and maintain professional boundaries?
- Have you ever done something you wish you could erase?
- What's the scariest thing you've ever done?
- What motivates you to want to work in a private residence or family office?
- What are the most important things in your life?
- How do you like to occupy your free time?
- How do you manage stress and maintain a positive attitude while at work?
- What continuing education have you taken in the last year?

CREATIVITY

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- Tell me a time you failed in a situation at work. Follow-up Question: How did you ensure that it wouldn't happen again? (Did they put a plan in place?)
- Can you describe a time when you had to come up with a creative solution to a complex problem?
- What is your favorite way to create luxury?
- How do you adapt to changes and unexpected challenges in your role?
- Can you describe a time when your organization skills significantly contributed to a project's success?

HARD & SOFT SKILLS

- What tools or systems do you use to stay organized and multiple that come with running a home?
- How do you manage your time?
- How do you define your priorities?
- Was there any training that you hope to take in the next year?
- Tell me a time when you saved your previous Principal money.
- Tell me about one of the more challenging projects you've taken on.
- What do you do if you noticed a significant risk to the family office's operation?
- In the last five years, what was one of the more exciting and enjoyable projects you've taken on?
- What professional accomplishment are you most proud of?
- What are two **hard skills** that you excel at that you feel will help with this position?
- What are the two **soft skills** that you excel at that you feel will help with this position?
- What is your approach when delivering negative news to key stakeholders? *Follow-up Question:* How do you handle an emotional response?
- How do you ensure effective communication?
- How do you deal with difficult Principals?

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• What negative feedback have you received in your career that you still think about to this day?

LEADERSHIP

- Tell me your leadership style.
- What would you purchase for \$100 to create value for the team?
- How do you deal with negative employees that your Principals have said they trust, and you can't fire them?
- How do you "win over" existing staff that may be averse to your changes?
- Tell me a time when you dealt with a challenging employee or an employee conflict.



HOUSEKEEPER INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

- How long have you been working as a housekeeper?
- What types of homes or environments have you cleaned before (e.g., apartments, houses, offices)?
- What cleaning products and equipment are you familiar with using?
- Can you share an example of a challenging cleaning situation you faced and how you resolved it?
- Tell me what NOT to use on soft stone countertops. (acids or abrasives)
- Tell me what NOT to use on Wood (alcohol)
- How do you organize a space to clean
- Tell me how you clean a toilet. (Cleanest to dirtiest)
- What chemicals do you NOT like?
- What makes a great housekeeper?
- What are common mistakes that a housekeeper can make?
- How to clean a shower?
- Give me some ironing tips.
- What is your laundry process?
- How long to iron a set of King Sheets?
- Stain removal process. (least invasive to most invasive)

WORK STYLE AND PREFERENCES

- What are your typical cleaning routines and processes?
- How do you prioritize tasks and manage your time efficiently?
- Do you prefer working independently or as part of a team?
- Are you comfortable taking direction and following specific instructions?

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ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS

- What do you enjoy most about being a housekeeper?
- What skill would you like to develop next?
- What are your long-term career goals in this field?
- Do you have any questions for me about the position or my home?
